An Exhibitor Packet will be set out for each exhibitor with your table #, name tag(s), concert tickets and show bag.

Exhibitor Tables:

Please set up your table how you wish, but please secure any items that could tip or fall off the table. Please **do not** stick any signs on the wall behind your table where you will find the R.I. Music Hall of Fame displays; they damage very easily. Company banners should be placed on the **front** of your table; duct tape and/or clips to attach to the tablecloth will work fine. **Please have print materials and/or samples to give away to the patrons;** it is our intent to educate the public about the wonderful services that the exhibitors provide and send them home armed with educational information.
